## You can join with NAG supporters at this event!

The eighth London World Naked Bike Ride will return to the streets of the capital on Saturday 11 June 2011. It is the largest daytime WNBR event in the world and allows riders to see the city sights from the comfort of a bike or skates. The ride is about 7 miles, from Hyde Park around central London streets then back to the Wellington Arch at Hyde Park Corner. It is easy and upbeat, many riders decorate their bodies and bikes with messages of protest against oil dependency, car culture, and body freedom. There is a special health & safety theme this year. It is free to enter and the event also attracts many non-riding participants.

From 2.00pm onwards **NAG** supporters can meet up in Hyde Park at a grassy bank by the sign-posted 1977 Silver Jubilee planted "Silver Bed", just 200yds to the north of the giant Achilles Statue. Here **NAG** management group members can update you on current **NAG** work and seek your views and comments before the ride starts.

Sadly, we will have to observe the time-limited 'nudity zone' conditions which the London WNBR collective will have agreed with the Royal Parks. This means that nudity will only be possible from 3.00pm, in preparation for the start of the Ride near the Achilles Statue, just in from the Queen Mother Gate on Park Lane. You might also like to bring a picnic for after (clothed again) in Hyde Park?

In 2010 the numbers of participants in the London WNBR were slightly down at just over 1,000. Some were in fancy dress, and from casual observation about 80% were not fully dressed, with about 35% totally nude (both sexes). Several **NAG** supporters participated in 2010 and this year it would be possible for **NAG** supporters to ride as an identified group in 2011. The ride starts in Hyde Park at 3.30pm.
