

# *The London Question* update

So far 50 naturists of both genders have supported *The London Question*, a Naturist Action Group project. Naturists assisting NAG with *The London Question* have already identified 25 parks and open spaces, as possible locations for naturism in London and most of these have now been checked. Your suggestions for additional sites to explore would be welcomed. NAG volunteers also went on a fact-finding mission, to see how citizens of Munich take to naturism.

So far in 2013 the NAG action in London has mainly focussed on Hampstead Heath, and an update on this will be given in the meeting below, to which you are invited.
