<b>2.0 Matters arising from previous minutes</b>	
2.1 Social Media: Peter has completed the social media strategy but left his laptop behind so will distribute it when he returns home.	Peter Knight

2.2 Children and Nudity: John asked about the academic research into this subject. Duncan explained that academic research often depends on money being available. While both BN and INF have set aside money for academic research, there is no indication that it would be used for independent research. Commissioning research is beyond NAG's financial ability. John suggested that, despite this inability, it might be useful if Duncan created a briefing paper. Duncan responded that this could be counterproductive as it might be seen to be seeking a particular outcome, and to be useful in stimulating genuinely impartial research, it needs to be very general in nature. He would consider it further, but with no significant funds available or the prospect of any, it would not be a high priority.	Duncan Heenan
2.3 Be Naked Day: John asked if National Be Naked Day was to be repeated. Duncan, who led the project for BN, said he was not certain because British Naturism's EC wouldn't make a decision early enough to properly organise it for summer 2018. Unable to work with the EC's approach, Duncan stepped down as project leader and no one has replaced him. John asked if NAG could perhaps take over the event in 2019. Duncan doubted it, as it would take a large number of volunteers to organise properly.

3.1 Duncan reported that the financially there has been no change to NAG's account except for a donation of £14.43 net, made since the annual account was published.

It concluded that NAG conducts a national survey of UK naturists to discover their collective opinions and develop new objectives from that, starting with a "blank sheet of paper".
